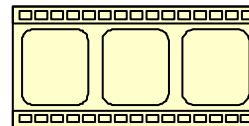
Composting - Each patrol has been provided with a bucket for composting. You can put all kitchen waste **except meat** into the compost. Try to empty your compost in the designated pit at least once each day to avoid attracting wasps and critters to your site.

Recycling - We have recycling stations around the camp for all of your,

CLEAN cans, glass, plastics (1-7), Refundables and other recycling will have separate drop-off spots. Emptying the juice boxes is also important, to minimizing the wasp and rodent factor. Your box board (no food) can be put into the big dumpster located near the compost pit. **Batteries** - We will be recycling dead, **non-recharge-**

able batteries! Please drop off all of your dead batteries in the buckets provided and don't put these into the regular garbage.
