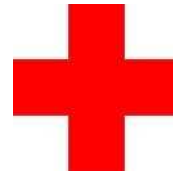

To have pictures taken with the Hot Air Balloon by the stage please speak to the **Entertainment Committee**. They can usually be found near the stage or maze.

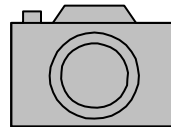
I WILL-I MUST-I CAN
